### How to Help a Picky Eater

Do you feel like mealtime is a battle to get your child to eat healthy foods, or to eat anything at all? Here are some tips that may help make meal time more successful.

### **Taste**

### Provide sauces and dips

<u>Sweet</u>: fruit dip, yogurt, soft cream cheese spread, peanut butter, etc.

<u>Savory</u>: ketchup, soy sauce, bbq sauce, cheese sauce, salad dressing, etc.

### **Texture**

Offer raw versions of normally cooked foods, or cooked versions of foods normally served raw, e.g.:

> Apples Spinach Carrots Broccoli

### Appearance

### Make the meal visually interesting



- ~Cut fruits and veggies into dippable french fry shapes
- ~Arrange food on the plate to be pretty and inviting.
- $\sim\!\!\operatorname{Provide}$  a special plate, utensil or cup that your child likes.
- ~Keep food portions small and offer more as needed.

### Attitude

### Keep it positive

Give positive feedback when your child takes bites and eats nicely. Enforce a "no thank you" helping-usually one or two bites-- for foods your child does not want to try. Do not engage with arguing or whining. Just say, "take a bite," then offer an interesting topic of conversation.

### Before the Meal

### Encourage your child to help with food preparation:

- ~Arrange baby carrots, apple slices, or cheese sticks on a plate.
- ~Peel veggies.
- ~Measure and mix ingredients.
- ~Set the table.


